(Entries will be accepted the day of the match if space permits)
- Classification: NRA Classification system will be used for the NRA Regional Match on Saturday.
(Membership in the NRA is NOT required)
NRA classification cards may be checked by statistical officer.
Unclassified shooters will compete in the Master Class.
Temporary classification may be used in making entry in the NRA Regional Match.
- Rifles: Match and Service rifles as defined by NRA and CMP latest rules.
- Ammo: Any SAFE ammo allowed. NO Tracer, Armor Piercing, or Incendiary allowed.
- Rules: Saturday – NRA High Power Rifle Rules will apply.
Sunday – CMP High Power Rifle Rules will apply.
(check the NRA and CMP for the latest competition modifications)
- Squadding: All competitors will be registered/squaded prior to matches & score/operate targets as assigned.
- Scoring: The ShotMarker electronic target system will be used. Competitors need to bring a smartphone or tablet with sufficient power for a full day of use. Competitors will be needed to assist with the set-up and take down of targets, as well as perform scoring. The paper score cards will be the official record for the match (NRA Rule 10.17). Those not familiar with this system should refer to the manual (https://www.autotricker.com/uploads/6/3/4/4/63444023/11_-_shotmarker_manual_apr2020.pdf) and use the system during a Forbes practice day. Help will be available, but we need you to be prepared. Competitor will be responsible for paying for the

- replacement of any system components damaged by their shots (Sensor & block \$40, sensor cables \$10, antennae and cable \$10).
- Targets: NRA approved targets will be used.
- Officials: Will be assigned by the match director.
- Challenges: A challenge fee of \$2.00 will be charged for each challenge made.

MATCH INFORMATION

NOTE: Due to scheduling with Watervliet, cannot use 300/600 yd lines prior to 1300 hrs.
Competitors should be prepared for both a regular shooting schedule as well as delays.

Anyone shooting from the 300/600 yard lines should have established zeroes prior to the match.
No practice firing will be permitted on any of the ranges during match days.

Saturday: NRA High Power Rifle Regional

2 sighters, 20 for record, standing slow fire, 22 min, 200 yds, SR-1 target
2 sighters, 20 for record in 2-10 shot strings, sitting rapid fire, 60 sec, 200 yds, SR-1 target
2 sighters, 20 for record in 2-10 shot strings, prone rapid fire, 70 sec, 300 yds, SR-3 target
2 sighters, 20 for record, prone slow fire, 22 min, 600 yds, MR-1 target

Sunday:

CMP Service Rifle EIC Match. No sighting shots. NO Refires (Alibi relays)
NOTE – Service rifles for this match. Rapid fire starts from Standing position. 10 shots
standing slow fire, 10 minutes, 200 yds, SR-1 target
10 shots sitting rapid fire, 60 seconds, 200 yds, SR-1 target
10 shots prone rapid fire, 70 seconds, 300 yds, SR-3 target
20 shots prone slow fire, 20 minutes, 600 yds, MR-1 target

Note: CHECK THE SCORE CARD BEFORE SIGNING IT TO VERIFY THAT IT IS CORRECT
Cards must be turned in promptly following each fired stage

SAFETY IS PARAMOUNT

EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATORS (EIC's) MUST BE VISIBLE IN RIFLE CHAMBER AT ALL TIMES

It is each shooters responsibility to show they can handle, operate, and fire their weapon in a safe manner.
Any shooter judged unable to conduct themself in this way will be removed from the firing line.
This is entirely at the discretion of the range officer calling the line or RSO. No refund will be given.

SPECIAL SAFETY NOTE

AT NO TIME WILL THE MUZZLE OF THE RIFLE BE POINTED ABOVE THE BERM/TARGETS WHEN LOADED

EXAMPLE

PUTTING THE BUTT OF THE RIFLE TO SHOULDER WHEN THE MUZZLE IS ABOVE THE NUMBER BOARDS

(This used to be a common practice during the standing phase. IT WILL NO LONGER BE ALLOWED)

FIRST VIOLATION – SHOOTER WILL BE GIVEN A WARNING

SECOND VIOLATION – SHOOTER WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE LINE FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE MATCH

Please practice these procedures before the match.

Awards – NRA Regional

NRA Regional: Aggregate awards (open awards).

1st place – (with min of 5 shooters)

2nd place – (with min 10 shooters)

3rd place – (with min 15 shooters)

In a class and category awards – 1st place 5 shooters, 2nd place 10 shooters, 3rd place 15 shooters

NOTE-There must be five or more in a class and category.

Less than five will be combined with another category or next higher class.

Less than five in the High Master class must compete for open awards only.

If shooter places for Open Award, not eligible for in class and category award.

Special Awards – High Senior, High Woman, and Hi Junior if five shooters per category

Awards – CMP Matches

EIC Match: CMP will award EIC credit points, badges, and achievement awards (Distinguished or Non-Distinguished) to competitors who qualify.

Awards - Grand Aggregate

Total of NRA Regional and CMP EIC Match Aggregates

Awards for 1st place 5 shooters, 2nd place 10 shooters, 3rd place 15 shooters

NOTE: Other awards may be provided based on the total of paid competitors and net proceeds.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Food: No food facilities during the day and no lunch breaks. Bring your own food.

Water: Drinking water will be available on the line and in the pits.

Billeting: Numerous motels within 5 miles of the range.

Trash: What you carry in, you carry out.

Membership: Competitors are encouraged to consider membership in Forbes R&P Club, affording them additional use of the range.
